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
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

INTRODUCTION TO OUR VISITORS

THE Chelmsford Society of Model Engineers and The Chelmsford Model Aircraft Club welcome you to this our Sixth major Exhibition. Apart from the pleasure it may give, we present it with the object of showing all those interested in Model Engineering and kindred Crafts that there exists in Chelmsford a Society whose members are ever ready to help the Youth of the district (and those not so young, for Model making is a hobby to interest all ages) with assistance and encouragement to enable them to maintain that gift of individual craftsmanship and skill, which is in danger of becoming a lost art in this over mechanised and automatic mass production age.

The Society, founded in an attic eighteen years ago by eight men and one lady, with an interest in Steam Locomotives, was originally known as "The Locomotive Brotherhood," but with increased membership and interests the scope of the Society was extended to other spheres of Model work, including Marine Models and Model Aircraft.

A library and workshop were acquired and progress was rapid until 1940, when the War dealt us, in common with other Societies, a blow which obliged us to disperse our equipment and put all our activities into winning the War.

A few older members, in their own workshops, and the Aircraft Section, under the able leadership of Mr. G. Foden (now Area Secretary of the S.M.A.E.) kept things going until the end of hostilities, when the Society once more set out to build up its former strength.

With no headquarters and most of our equipment lost by enemy action and in the general dispersal, we slowly gained momentum, and this year we are in the happy position of having approximately 100 members, equally divided between the Chelmsford Society of Model Engineers and its healthy amalgamated daughter Society, The Chelmsford Model Aircraft Club.

We are still without a communal workshop, but by the generosity of our Vice-President, Mr. W. Gordon Spencer, we now have the use of a small hut in which to meet and work. This last year we have added to our assets 150ft. run of passenger carrying track which, being portable, has been of value in earning money for charity and other worthy causes at eight local fetes during the past summer.

We are now regaining our former position amongst the many other Societies in the Country and we trust that the present Exhibition will interest you. To all our visitors we extend our thanks and we hope that our efforts will have the happy outcome of recruiting more members to our Society. It is a fascinating and useful hobby—why not join us?
